
1. Introduction

Ali Yavar Jung National Institute of Speech and Hearing Disabilities (Divyangjan) (AYJNISHD(D)), Mumbai was established on 9th August, 1983. It is an autonomous organisation under the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, New Delhi. Regional Centres of the Institute have been established at Kolkata (1984), Noida (1986), Secunderabad (1986) and Janla (1986- in association with Government of Orissa). These are centres aimed at meeting the local and regional needs in terms of manpower development and services.

Aims and Objectives of AYJNISHD is to provide manpower development in the area of Speech & Hearing Impairment, education of persons with hearing impairment and Sign Language. Institute also provide diagnostic and therapeutic services to persons with all age group with speech, language and hearing disorders. Research and dissemination of information is also targeted. Last three years activities and achievements of the Institute have been highlighted below.

2. Diagnostic & Therapeutic Services

The Institute provides comprehensive diagnostic, therapeutic, educational and vocational services to persons with speech and/or hearing disabilities. As a training and research institute, the services are rendered in the best possible way to meet the needs of both rural as well as urban clients. An inter-disciplinary team of audiologists, speech language pathologists, special educators, psychologists, social workers, ENT specialists, Pediatricians and neurologists maintain a high standard of rehabilitation services. There has been steady increases in number of client served in last three years in all departments.



Public education pamphlets are also developed to create awareness among the general public. 72242 Number of educational pamphlets, were distributed from Institute and in camps.

Government of Maharashtra approved the proposal of AYJNISHD to be the one of the Centre for issue of the hearing Disability Certificate with the jurisdiction of Mumbai and suburban area in 2016. So far 700 persons

were issued Hearing Disability certificate. Certificate are issued using SADM software of Govt. of Maharashtra. In 2016-17, on behalf of the Commissioner Disabilities, Government of Maharashtra, AYJNISHD developed a tool to assess the infrastructure of the special schools for the children with hearing disability and also in collaboration of National Convention of Educator of the deaf (Maharashtra chapter) started orientation program for the special educators in the area of early intervention for children with hearing impairment.

3. New Initiatives

a) BTE digital Programmable Hearing Aid:

BTE digital programmable Hearing Aids were introduced in February, 2015 under the ADIP Scheme of Government of India and has been in use for distribution among the urban as well as rural clients. In 2015-16 AYJNISHD participated in mega camp held at Varanasi where more than 3000 BTE hearing aid were distributed. In 2016-17, in the month of September, 2016 AYJNISHD participated in creating Guinness World Record for fitting of 600 hearing aids at same site within eight hours at Navsari, Gujarat. Guinness World Records officials handed over the certificate of Guinness World Records to the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 23rd October, 2016 at another mega camp held at Baroda, Gujarat.

b) Cochlear Implants

AYJNISHD has been the nodal Agency for the implementation of Cochlear Implant program all over the Nation. 172 hospitals have been empaneled for the Cochlear implant surgery across India. Cochlear Implant is modern technology for the benefit of persons with deafness. After the surgery, the deaf children can able to hear, and with appropriate training, can able to talk. Government of India is providing funds upto Rs 6.00 lakhs per child to parents having monthly income less than Rs.15,000/-. So far 700 CI surgeries have been undertaken.

c) Cochlear Implant under CSR Activity


Under CSR activity 136 cochlear Implant were sponsored by various Government and Corporate Sectors through ALIMCO, Kanpur. AYJNISHD received approval of **Rs.2.65 crores** from State Bank of India Foundation, Mumbai, under **Shravan Shakti Project** for 50 implants for children residing in West Bengal. SBI further proposed to extend the scheme to other states too.

4. Academic Activity

AYJNISHD(D), Mumbai and its Regional Centres at Kolkata, Secunderabad, Noida and Janla, Odisha conducts Doctoral, Postgraduate, Graduate, Undergraduate, and Diploma level courses and certificate - vocational courses affiliated to respective universities in the concerned State/Directorate of Technical Education/ITI and recognized by Rehabilitation Council of India. Most of our passed out students have good access to job opportunity and self-entrepreneurship. Break-up of the number of students enrolled under Long Term training Programmes during last three years is given below —



Apart from long term training programme, institute also conducts Short Term Training Programmes (STTP) for various professionals and members of community. In last three years there has been a steady growth in the number of short term training programmes and beneficiaries. 14471 number of beneficiaries participated in various short term training programmes during last three years.

5. Library

To support the academic achievement of students, AYJNISHD has well equipped modern Library with total number of 17363 books and E - Resources. In last three years following efforts have been made to develop library in modern ways, such as:

- Developed Digital Library by using open source software-D Space.
- Procurement of multi-site e-journals.
- 289 books were added in last 3 years.
- Subscribed N-List database.

6. Research Activity

Research projects have been designed to increase and improve the quality of rehabilitation services. The projects are aimed at evolving service modules and diagnostic tests that can be used or replicated by other organizations. In recently completed research work, the research concluded the performance of children using Cochlear Implant under ADIP scheme are:

- Steady progress in receptive and expressive vocabulary acquisition.
- Achievement of receptive and expressive language age upto 2 and half years.
- Achievement of auditory perception up to the extent of understanding sentences and conversations.
- Achievement of spoken language skills up to the extent of expressing in 3-4 word sentences.
- Significant variation in scores across implanted children attributed to several factors such as regularity in therapy, inputs from parents, device use, among others.


Two of the Ph.D Scholars are awarded Ph.D in Audiology & Speech Pathology and five scholars got the approval of Research Advisory Committee for submission of Ph.D thesis in 2017.

AYJNISHD for the first time published AYJNIHH-Journal of Communication Disorders in 2016.

7. Outreach & Extension Activity

The main objectives of the Institute's Outreach and Extension Services have been to cater to the welfare and rehabilitation of persons with speech and hearing impairment in far flung areas, providing and/or initiating rehabilitative services, creating awareness in the community on prevention and early identification, bringing about attitudinal changes towards persons with hearing impairment and strengthening the existing

institutions. Diagnostic & distribution camps were held in different places across the country. In last three years AYJNISHD has touched each state in India. During last three years, 316 camps were held in different states of the country which is given below.



8. Skill Development Training Programme


AYJNISHD had been entrusted to organize skill development programme for Persons with Disabilities. AYJNISHD has successfully trained PwDs as per given target during last three years. Funds under SIPDA has been released for conducting skill development programs. AYJNISHD, Mumbai facilitated (499 for wage employment and 152 for self-employment) persons with hearing disability to get jobs in various organizations in last three years and also started dissemination of job opportunities among the target group.



9. Disability Information Line

Disability Information Line was created to enable the public to have easy access through telephone to information regarding disabilities, to know the benefits/services offered through various schemes and agencies, and addresses of service providers at the place of caller. The information is available on IVRS (through telephone 24 x 7), SMS, E-mail and dialogue modes (through operator on working days - working hours) in Hindi, English and local language which is toll free. DIL is implemented in the states of Maharashtra-Goa, Delhi, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Odisha, West Bengal, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Sikkim Telecom Circles.

In last three years DIL project has been rationally programmed to cut the cost and increase the efficiency which can be seen from the following table as the number of calls is increased considerably:




Third party evaluation is also completed by Composite Regional Centre, Patna and NAB, Mumbai which reported utility of DIL.

10. Welfare Activities of students:








11. Expenditure
