## Guidelines

- Themes:**
1. Technological advances and persons with disability
  2. Catch them Young
  3. Employment of persons with disability in urban slums
  4. Play school and children with disabilities.

**1. Language: Hindi/English or any Indian Language with Subtitles in Hindi/English only.**

**2. Duration: One-Minute/30 Seconds**

(The film must be exactly 60/30 seconds in total running time, including titles and credits.)

**3. Time and Last Date of Submission: 2nd August 2010, 5pm# and only one entry by one person. Results will be announced on the Website of the Institute on 9<sup>th</sup> August 2010.**

**4. Selection of Themes: 'Disability issues' (4 choices are available)**

**5. Venue of shooting film: Any permissible venue. However necessary permits to be obtained by the applicant.**

**6. \*Categories:**

**a. FEATURE**

(Works that are acted out by flesh-and-blood actors, also known as "live action.")

**b. ANIMATION**

(Illusion of motion by consecutive display of static images, which have been created by hand or on the computer)

**c. DOCUMENTARY**

(A factual following of an event or person to gain an understanding of a particular point or issue)

**d. FAN-FILM:**

A film or mash-up inspired by a movie, television show, comic book, or a similar source, created by fans rather than by the source's, copyright holders, or creators.

**7. Format: Quicktime or Windows Media Player format. (CD/DVD)**
