TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Warranty period 24 months.
2. Free repairing facilities for hearing aids during the warranty period.
3. For BTE programmable digital hearing aids software compatible with the hearing aids to be supplied along with programming cables and necessary training to the audiologist.
4. Bank guarantee @ 10 % of value of the purchase order should be furnished by the company.
5. Ordered hearing aids should be dispatch to the locations within 30 days of the receipt of purchase order by the company.
6. Any price reduction during the period of rate contract should be passed on to the Institute by the company.
7. The company should supply 5 % of the order hearing aids as 'Loaning Hearing Aids'.

8. The Company should provide an indelible stamp on the product, marked "ISSUED UNDER ADIP SCHEME OF MINISTRY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT, GOVT. OF INDIA"
9. AYJNISHD (D) shall without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as Liquidated Damages a sum equivalent to 2.5% of the price of delayed Goods or unperformed services for delay of each day until actual delivery or performance, up to a maximum deduction of 20% of the contract price. Once the maximum is reached AYJNISHD (D) may consider termination of the contract and can forfeit the Performance Guarantee amount.
10. Payment will be made within thirty working days after the supply is made satisfactorily.
11. Tenderer should agree to allow usual inspection and check for operation upto 1 % of the order or 1 piece, whichever is more by the consignee before acceptable and payment.
